Founded in 2009 by its' namesake, The Eileen S. Kaminsky Family Foundation (ESKFF) is an artist residency program for local, national, and international mid-career, emerging artists, and students. Its mission is to provide stipends for materials, grants, educational programs, exhibition opportunities, visiting professionals, and studio space in an environment that promotes self-growth, encourages dialogue and collaboration between artists, where it is safe to experiment and take creative risks.

Galleri Ramfjord was founded in 1998 by Elisabeth Ramfjord. Centrally located in Oslo, the gallery's mission has been to champion newcomers and emerging artists. After almost 25 years in business the gallery now also represents several mid-career and well-established artists. A dynamic exhibition venue in downtown Oslo, Galleri Ramfjord is known for its frequent cross-disciplinary events and for representing contemporary figurative art. While the main focus is on oil painting, there is also a wide range of drawing, photography, sculpture and installation on display.

In January 2015, Elisabeth Ramfjord curated an exhibition for ESKFF at MANA Contemporary Museum in Jersey City, while securing 7-8 artist-in-residence spaces for her represented artists from 2015 until recent. She is currently on the Board of Directors at ESKFF and both have continued the relationship.
